**Coffee Mornings took in aid of pilgrimages by two of our students to Medjugorje.**

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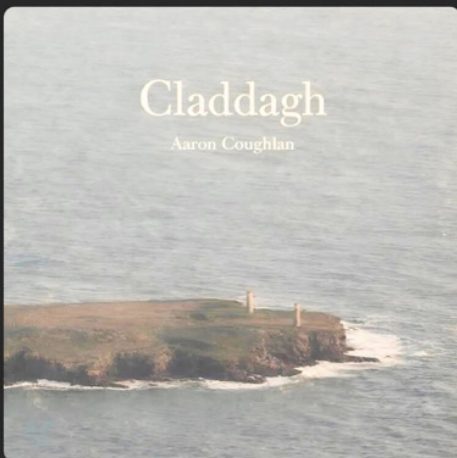
